Learning objectives

40-60+ months:


- Recognises numerals 1 to 5.
- Counts up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item.
- Counts actions or objects which cannot be moved.
- Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.
- Counts an irregular arrangement of up to ten objects.
- Estimates how many objects they can see and checks by counting them.

Early Learning Goal:

Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number.


Activity 1 - Count and Match

1. Place a button inside each circle. Count the buttons.





2. Print your finger inside each circle. Count the finger prints.





3. Print a row of finger prints for your friend to count in the box below:




Activity 2 - Spot the Ladybirds

1. Can you guess how many spots are on this ladybird? Now count and check your answer.





